As you will note this year we are not going to be doing a KS2 Advent production. We have given a lot of thought to this and the decision has not been taken lightly. The reasons for this are detailed below, not in any particular order:

Each KS2 class also prepares and leads an advent liturgy in school - these are very spiritual and a lot of effort, time & thought are put into these.

Last year we received a number of concerns from parents about the amount of time children were missing from their learning to walk to and from church.

We have issues securing enough adults to walk to & from church and often have to take KS1 staff which impacts on learning in KS1.

There have been an increase in instances of parents/carers/family members speaking inappropriately to staff at all levels regarding eg tickets, parts allocated to children. We have instances of people speaking inappropriately on the evening of the performance to those involved in organising/attending the event.

We have had equipment damaged by visitors attending the performance.

Over the past couple of years, the stress and demands of the production have contributed to staff illness.

We are holding two parent comprehension sessions on Friday 18th November at 2:30pm and Monday 21st November at 5pm.


