and wear an Easter Bonnet.


There will be the chance to show off their Easter Bonnets during the day, and prizes will be awarded by School Council for creativity and fun ideas!

<u>Y5 "Cricket in the</u> Classroom"

Y5 will be visiting the Yorkshire County Cricket Club in Leeds on Thursday 27th April. Children will need to arrive at school for 8:45 so we can leave promptly on the coach at 9am.

We will be at the Indoor Cricket Centre arriving at 10am and leaving at 2:30. Please be aware as we will not be leaving the club until 2:30, we may not arrive back to school until approx. 3:30pm. The morning consists of a 90 minute classroom session linking cricket to English, Numeracy and Geography, and then 90 minutes of cricket based activities. After lunch, there will be a behind the scenes tour of Headingley Cricket Ground.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle on the day. If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like to order a packed lunch please complete the slip below. Children should wear warm comfortable clothing suitable for participating in physical activity e.g. tracksuit bottoms and trainers or equivalent, but children do need to wear their school jumper or school polo shirt.




The children from
