#### "Virtues to Live by"



#### Dear parents/carers,

STM will be continuing with our year-long activity with the children celebrating "Virtues to Live By". If you recall, this is a diocesan initiative in which several area Catholic schools are participating.

We will have four virtues to focus on for every term. Every week, in our Key Stage Assemblies, the children will be participating in a collective worship based around the theme. Every class will have posters displayed in class around that theme, including how to "live out" the theme in real life.

Then every Friday, during Celebration Assembly, one child from each class will receive a certificate if they have displayed this virtue consistently or in a special way during the week. This will also be displayed weekly in our newsletter.

Here is some reminder information about the programme:

#### Guiding Principles

To ensure children and young people are given opportunities to:

- 1. Experience a positive and purposeful ethos providing a sense of belonging to their school community.
- 2. Grow in their knowledge and understanding of the virtues.
- 3. Practise the virtues to further the call to live life to the full.
- 4. Appreciate the connection between biblical and practical wisdom and living.
- 5. Hear the Christian story and encounter it in practice.
- 6. Understand their uniqueness and dignity as made in the image and likeness of God.
- 7. Know that our limitations are also opportunities for growth.
- 8. To notice, to reflect, to pray and to play
- 9. To exercise the cognitive, affective and behavioural components of character: know it in your head, feel it in your heart and show it with your hands.






#### Congratulations to

#### <u>Y3 trip to Magna</u> <u>Wednesday 2nd February 2022</u>

On Wednesday 2nd February 2022 Y3 will be visiting Magna to take part in and learn more about Magnets as part of our spring science learning! The coach will be collecting us from school at 9.15am so please ensure that your child arrives to school on time so that we can set off on time. The coach will be dropping us off at school again at 3pm. As the trip will be taking place over lunchtime, your child will need a packed lunch and a water bottle. Please send your child to school in their normal school uniform with a coat over the top.

The contribution is £12, which includes the Entry Fee and coach travel. Payments should be made and consent given on Parentmail.

If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled.

#### <u>Y1 Trip to Emergency Services Museum</u> <u>Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2022</u>

On Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2022, Year 1 children will visit the National Emergency Services Museum in Sheffield to learn all about the history of The Great Fire of London. Children will travel back in time to 1666 when King Charles II was on the throne and a huge fire ravaged London, to learn how the Great Fire was extinguished and the legacy it holds. Children will get the opportunity to handle real and replica objects, dress up as a soldier fighting the fire and try some of the methods they used. This workshop is in collaboration with South Yorkshire Fire and Rescue bringing history and vital life safety together.

The coach will be leaving school around 9.15am so please arrive to school promptly as normal. We will be returning to school before the end of the school day (approx. 2.30pm).

The contribution is £13, which includes the workshop and coach travel. Payments should be made and consent given on Parentmail.

If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled.

# F2 Trip to Eureka Museum Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022

F2 will be visiting EUREKA! Children's Museum on Thursday the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2022. On our trip we will be exploring the amazing galleries (including All About Me and SoundSpace) as well as enjoying an EYFS story time in the new EYFS gallery! We will be leaving school on the coach at 8.30am, so all children will need to be in school at 8.15am at latest. We will be departing EUREKA at 2.30pm so we expect to be back at school by 4.00pm (approx). We will update parents on the day if we will be any earlier or later than this time.

Children should be in school uniform for this trip, wearing sensible footwear and a coat for the journey there and back. Children will also need a packed lunch and a filled water bottle for the day. We will be providing snack and milk. Please indicate on Parentmail if you would like your child to have packed lunch provided through school or if they will be bringing one from home.

The total contribution for each child is £20 - this includes the full day at EUREKA!, coach travel there and back and the EYFS Story time workshop. Please note if we do not receive enough contributions the trip may have to be cancelled.
