## Children's Work - Parent/Carer Review Visits



Dear parents/carers,

STM will be continuing with our year-long activity with the children celebrating "Virtues to Live By". If you recall, this is a diocesan initiative in which several area Catholic schools are participating.

We will have four virtues to focus on for every term. Every week, in our Key Stage Assemblies, the children will be participating in a collective worship based around the theme. Every class will have posters displayed in class around that theme, including how to "live out" the theme in real life.

Then every Friday, during Celebration Assembly, one child from each class will receive a certificate if they have displayed this virtue consistently or in a special way during the week. This will also be displayed weekly in our newsletter.

Here is some reminder information about the programme:

#### **Guiding Principles**

To ensure children and young people are given opportunities to:

1. Experience a positive and purposeful ethos providing a sense of belonging to their school community.

- 2. Grow in their knowledge and understanding of the virtues.
- 3. Practise the virtues to further the call to live life to the full.
- 4. Appreciate the connection between biblical and practical wisdom and living.
- 5. Hear the Christian story and encounter it in practice.
- 6. Understand their uniqueness and dignity as made in the image and likeness of God.
- 7. Know that our limitations are also opportunities for growth.
- 8. To notice, to reflect, to pray and to play

9. To exercise the cognitive, affective and behavioural components of character: know it in your head, feel it in your heart and show it with your hands.

#### <u>KS1 & KS2 Production of the Railway Children</u> <u>Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2022</u>

KS1 and KS2 will get the chance to watch M&M theatrical production of the Railway children on the morning of 27<sup>th</sup> April 2022.

The cost per child is a contribution of £3 for children in classes Y1 to Y5 and £4 for Y6 children, as they will also have a workshop after the production. Payment and consent for your child to attend should be via Parentmail.

#### <u>Y1 Trip to The Butterfly House</u> <u>Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2022</u>

On Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2022, Year 1 children will visit the Tropical Butterfly House Wildlife and Falconry Centre in Sheffield to experience all things animal! Children will take part in a workshop called "feathers, fur and scales" to widen their knowledge about animal classification. They will learn about the main differences between groups of animals, whilst meeting some of the scaly, furred and feathered friends!

The coach will be leaving school around 9am so please arrive to school promptly at normal time. We will be returning to school before the end of the school day (3.20pm approx.). Children will need a packed lunch on this day. Please indicate on Parentmail if you would like your child to have a packed lunch provided through school or if they will be bringing one from home.

The cost is being subsidised by the school and the contribution is  $\pm 16.00$  which includes entry, the workshop and coach travel.

Payments should be made and consent given on ParentMail.

If we do not receive enough contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled

#### <u>Y5 Trip to Gulliver's Valley</u> <u>Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2022</u>

On Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May the Y5 class will be going on a trip to Gulliver's Valley to take part in 'Gully's Art Fest'. This exciting opportunity will give the children a chance to extend their learning outside the classroom and broaden their awareness of the creative opportunities Rotherham and the surrounding areas have to offer for its future generations. We will be travelling by coach and leaving school at approximately 10am. We will be arriving back to school at approximately 3pm. All children must bring a packed lunch and a water bottle to take with them on the trip. If you require a packed lunch to be provided by school then please contact the school office to place your child's order. Please give permission for your child to attend this trip via ParentMail. Entrance to Gulliver's Valley is free of charge and the cost of the coach has been subsidised. The contribution for transport per child is £6.50. <u>Please be aware that if we do not receive enough contributions for the transport costs then the trip may have to be cancelled.</u>

#### <u>Y6 York Residential</u> <u>Monday 27<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2022</u>

The total cost per child is  $\pm 155$ , which includes accommodation, transport, food and activities throughout the trip.

Payments should be made on Parentmail, with the balance needing to be paid in full by Friday 22 April 2022.

#### Judaism workshops for Y1, Y3 and Y5 Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May

Children in Y1, Y3 and Y5 will be taking part in a Judaism workshop, which will be run virtually by Rabbi Zvi. The workshops will provide the children with a highly valuable learning experience as Rabbi Zvi will be further expanding on the knowledge taught to these classes during our other faiths week. The children will also be given the chance to get hands on and examine religious artifacts, linking to the topics explored during the sessions. Please give consent for your child to attend the workshop via ParentMail. The cost of the workshop will be  $\pounds 2$  per child and contributions can be made via Parent Mail. Please be aware that we may have to cancel the workshops if we do not receive enough contributions.
